

Life Cycle of a Bee


Instructions


- 1-2: Print game board on cardstock and laminate. Cut out the die and assemble. Use bee erasers, buttons, or even pennies for pawns. Roll the die and move pawns accordingly.
- 3: Print on cardstock. Cut out pieces and color. Fold tab and staple or glue. String pieces on yarn in the order of the life cycle.
- 4: Complete the maze. You can laminate this page and use dry erase markers to make it reusable.
- 5: Color the pictures and trace the vocabulary words.
- 6: Print on cardstock and laminate. Cut apart the puzzles, and have children reassemble.
- 7: Cut out the images at the bottom of the page, and glue them in the correct row to complete the sequence.
- 8: Have students write the correct term on each line. You can cut out the pages and staple them together to create a mini-book, if you'd like.
- 9-10: Cut the boxes on page 10. Glue them on page 9. You could also print pages on cardstock and laminate. Add velcro dots to each square on page 9 and the back of each box on page 10.
- 11: Cut out the numbers at the bottom of the page. Glue them in the correct box.
- 12: Print on cardstock. Cut page into 2 pieces - the slider box and the slider strip. Cut slits in the box, and slide strip through the slits. Have child retell the life cycle sequence.
- 13: Follow the directions on the page to assemble the spinning top.
- 14: Cut out the labels and glue them in the correct box.
- 15: Color the life cycle poster.
- 16: Count the life cycle pictures, and write the number in the boxes at the bottom of the page.
- 17-19: Print on cardstock and laminate. Have children build the life cycle with playdoh.




Instructions: Cut along the bold lines. Cut through the centers to the black dot.
